


Bridging gaps between Keweenaw communities by engaging in youth philanthropy and developing student leadership

BIGGEST AREAS OF CONCERN FOR STUDENTS IN YOUR SCHOOL

Copper Country students are most concerned (definitely to somewhat) about Stress & Anxiety (1,379), Vaping (1,293), Depression (1,143) and Nicotine Use (970).



ADDITIONAL PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES

Students wished there were more recreational and artistic activities available to them.

OTHER NOTES

- 55% of students are interesting in learning more about budget and finance before to prepare for life after high school.
- 53% of students would like more job and career exploration opportunities.
